As a final assessment for *The Scarlet Letter*, you will be working on an alphabet review of the novel. You will write a poem using the letters of the alphabet to begin each new line. Poems may be rhyming or free verse. Each letter of your poem should stand for something in *The Scarlet Letter*.

EXAMPLE 1

Vengeance from A to Z $\{DO NOT FORGET A CREATIVE TITLE\}$

A is for the letter Hester wears upon her bosom.

B is for the Black Man who haunts the forest.

C is for Chillingworth who seeks his vengeance.

D is for denial that Dimmesdale finds himself in.

E is for everyone who sins in this Boston community.

F is for failure to abide by God's laws.

EXAMPLE 2

Vengeance for A to Z {DO NOT FORGET A CREATIVE TITLE}

Always being stared at is what Hester must suffer.

Burdened by the guilt of sin is what Hester must feel.

Constantly trying to get her to reveal her secret is what the Goodwives do.

Dimmesdale tries tirelessly to get her to confess her secret.

Everlasting lies plague Hester, Dimmesdale, and Roger alike.

Failure to abide by God's laws have landed them all in this forest of guilt.
