I. <u>IDEAS</u>

*Main theme/thesis

- *Supporting facts (reasonable)
- *Strong conclusion

III. STYLE/WORD CHOICE

*Creativity *Risk taking *Appropriate use of literary techniques (based upon assignment) *Varied/unique words *Avoid repetition

II. ORGANIZATION/FLUENCY

*Legibility *Logic/unity *Staying on task *Follow through *Supporting facts *Consistent control *Clear transitions *Varied types of sentences *Rhythmic flow

IV. CONVENTIONS

*Basic mastery of mechanical skills (capitalization, usage, punctuation, spelling, sentence formation) *Paragraphing
